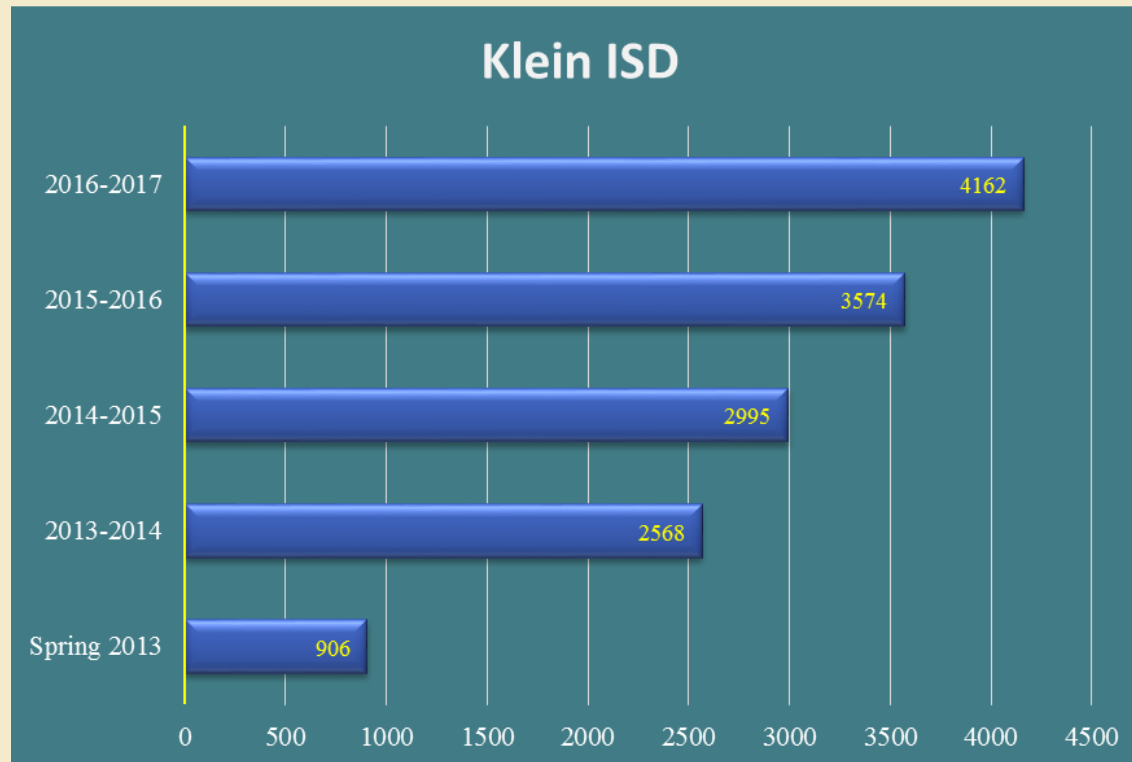

- ❖ Courses are taught by college faculty or college-approved high school instructors meeting the same standards and requirements of regularly employed college faculty
- ❖ Courses meet Texas Common Core requirements and are transferable to any public college or university in the state of Texas
- ❖ Academic and Workforce courses are available

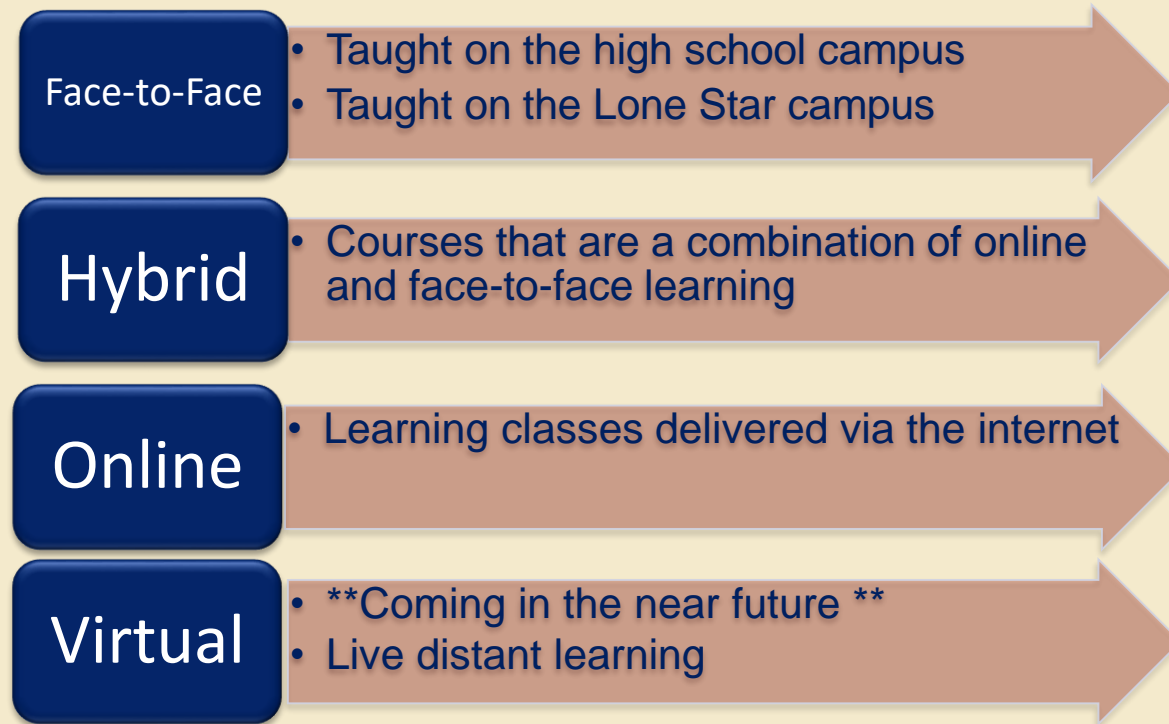
Benefits of Dual Credit Courses

How do I begin?

- ❖ Complete the online LSC application. Write down your Lone Star ID# and User Name/Password
- ❖ Meningitis Vaccination- Required for students taking a class on a LSC campus.
- ❖ Placement Testing

The “Blue” Packet

- ❖ Placement testing- March 2017- UP is coming to YOUR CAMPUS to “TSI” test students
 - Alternate option- test on UP campus
- ❖ Once your student has brought their college-ready placement test scores to the dual credit counselor, your student will receive a blue ***Dual Credit/ Exceptional Admissions PACKET.***
- ❖ The dual credit counselor will complete their portion of the “Dual Credit/ Exceptional Admissions” form and then the student and parent will complete the rest of the packet.
- ❖ This ***Dual Credit/ Exceptional Admissions packet*** is then:
 - Delivered to KISD Dual Credit counselor in time for registration deadline
OR
 - Delivered to Lone Star College University Park for course registration and payment (if past campus pickup deadline)

Financials/ Payment Process

What will the cost be for my dual credit coursework?

For Dual Credit students, tuition is waived and students only pay fees and textbooks.

- ❖ On Klein ISD campus: \$66(3 credit hrs)
- ❖ On LSC campus: \$66+20 campus fee
- ❖ Online course: \$66+ \$ 45 (\$15 per credit hour online fee)

How will I make my payment?

❖ Students are encouraged to pay their fee online. Directions on how to pay online will be attached to the registration statement and can also be found on the Klein ISD dual credit website.

- Students may also visit the Bursar/Cashier Office at LSC – University Park and pay in person
