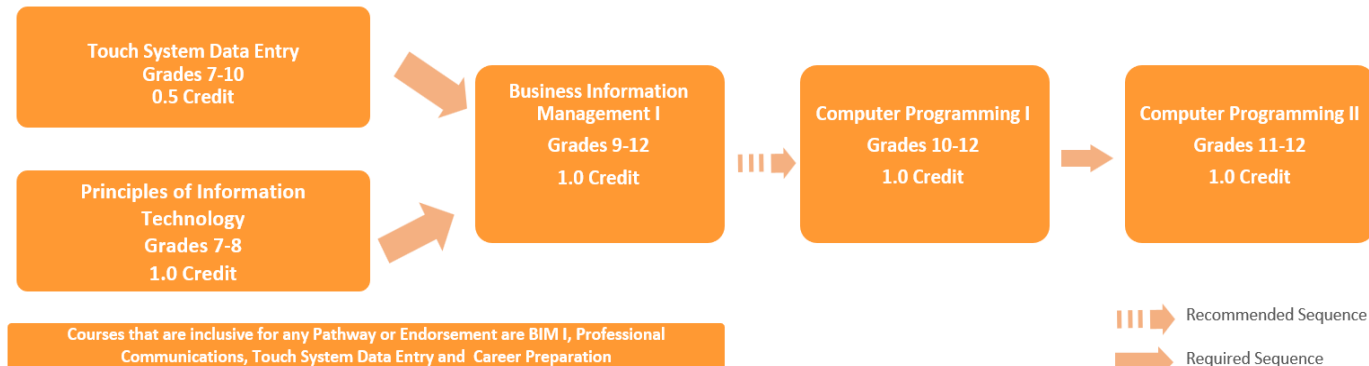


Business & Industry Pathway – Programming and Software
